Mission statement

The mission of the Placer Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals is to enhance the lives of companion animals and support the human-animal bond.

Our Vision

The vision of Placer SPCA is to ensure:

-  Every adoptable companion animal in Placer County has a home.
-  Every lost companion animal in Placer County is reunited with its owner.
-  Every dog and cat owner in Placer County has access to affordable spay and neuter services.
-  Every companion animal is treated with kindness and respect.





Placer SPCA launched the **SOS Emergency Fund**, a program that offers financial assistance to keep people and pets together during these challenging times.



In 2009, the Humane Education Department held our first Be Kind to Animals Day.



In 2009, **2,356** animals were adopted, an increase of 13% from 2008.

Through our foster care program, we had over **1,000** placements of animals in need, an increase of more than 150% from 2008.

1,562 animals received medical care through the Guardian Angel program.

404 lost animals were reunited with their families.



2,202 vouchers were issued to residents of Placer County for subsidized spay and neuter services through the Spay and Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP).

In its second year of operation, the UAIC Spay and Neuter Clinic at the Placer SPCA was used for more than 1,000 surgeries. The ability to spay and neuter onsite has allowed us to minimize the wait for adopted animals to go to their new homes.



Charity Navigator awarded Placer SPCA a four star rating for the third consecutive year. Fewer than 11% of all nonprofits evaluated nationwide receive this "exceptional" rating three years in a row.



Placer SPCA was named the **2009 Outstanding Nonprofit Organization of the Year** by the Sacramento Nonprofit Resource Center. This honor is very meaningful, as there are approximately 8,000 nonprofit organizations in the Sacramento Metropolitan area.



Volunteers contributed **69,507** hours. The programs and services offered by Placer SPCA would not be possible without the efforts of volunteers.

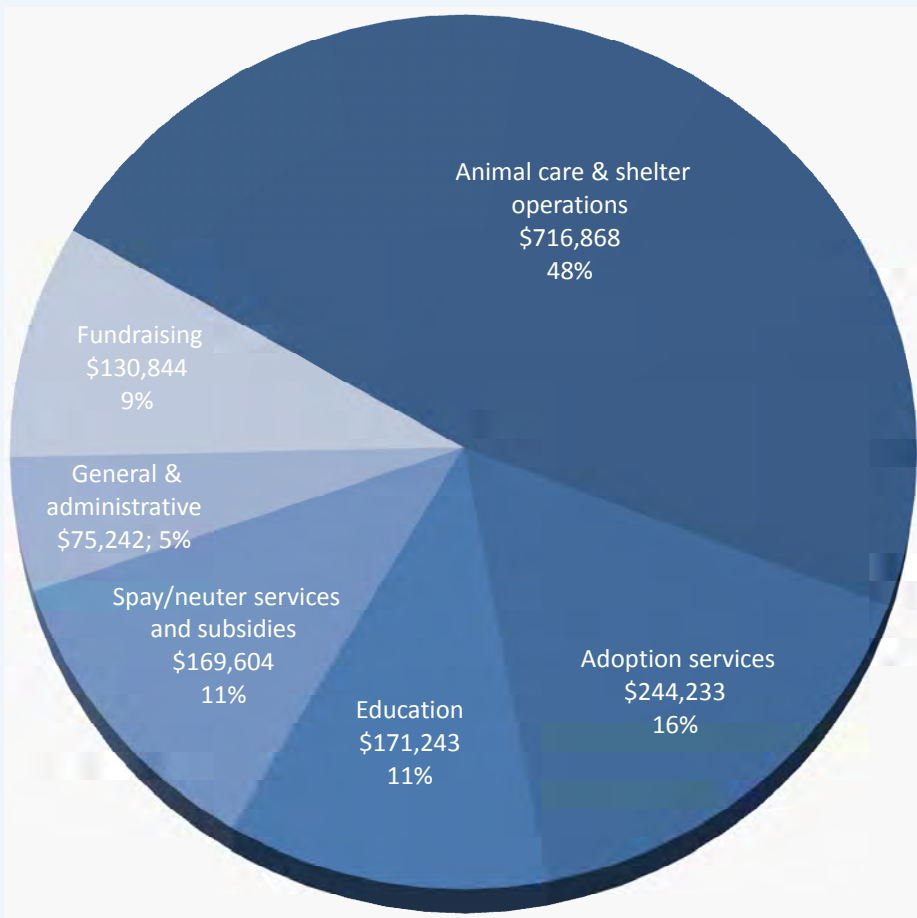
