Placer SPCA offers Free Spay and Neuter for Cats in the 95678 Zip Code with a Goal of Altering 1,000 Cats in One Year

During the warm spring and summer months, there are times at the Placer SPCA when 30 or more cats and kittens arrive in a single day, some in carriers, some in cardboard boxes. This is called kitten season. Shelter staff scramble to find foster homes for those too young for adoption, while the cat kennels at the Companion Animal Care Center are full to capacity.

In 2010, the Placer SPCA received a total of 2,300 cats from the 95678 zip code, a large section within the city of Roseville, and 75% of them were unaltered.

Thanks to a grant from PetSmart Charities®, we are able to offer free spay and neuter assistance to residents of the 95678 zip code, with a goal of altering 1,000 cats between now and September 2012.

Spay and neuter surgeries will be performed by local veterinarians who participate in Placer SPCA's Spay and Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP), and also at mobile clinics to be held in partnership with Animal Save, based in Grass Valley. The Animal Save mobile clinic will be scheduled at Roseville locations monthly, and can perform up to 25 spay or neuter surgeries in one day, by appointment through SNAP.

Residents of 95678 are encouraged to have their own cats or free-roaming cats spayed or neutered through this program. Call today!

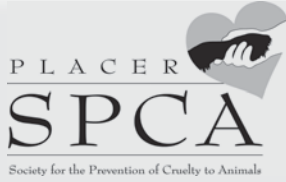

Placer SPCA cats and kittens waiting for adoption are now at Pet Food Express at Fountains in Roseville.

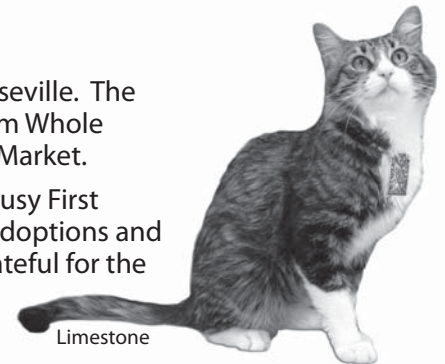
