With 16 Kittens Arriving Each Hour Placer SPCA Braces for Cat Crisis

Thirty-two kittens – that’s how many the Placer SPCA has received in the last two hours to add to the 99 cats and 63 kittens already at the Center. 88 more kittens are in volunteer foster homes. Some need round-the-clock bottle feeding, others have special medical needs, and some are ready to go up for adoption. “We need to call in the Calvary,” says Leilani Vierra, Chief Executive Officer at the PSPCA in Roseville. “It’s the start of kitten season and this is really going to be tough.” Vierra states they will need volunteers to help with the care of the animals not only at the Center but additional folks willing to provide temporary care in their homes. “We also need resources to care for these animals. Kitten food, formula, and cash donations are needed.”

“Most importantly,” says Matt Green, Director of Operations, “we need to find these wonderful animals good loving homes. That’s why we are offering to adopt kittens, who have been spayed or neutered, tested for common feline viruses, vaccinated, and microchipped for \$60 each or two for \$100.”
