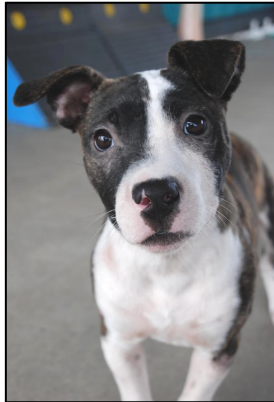

Did you know?

- ✓ Spaying and/or neutering your pets helps them live longer, healthier lives.
- ✓ Spayed or neutered pets are more affectionate companions.
- ✓ Spayed and neutered pets are less likely to wander and end up injured or killed.
- ✓ Spaying and neutering eases the overwhelming pet overpopulation that burdens our area shelters.

What if I cannot afford to pay for spay or neuter surgery?

We can help! If you live in Placer County and are in need of spay/neuter assistance for your cat, dog, rabbit, or feral (wild) cat living on your property*, please call our SNAP Hotline at **(916) 782-7722, ext. 201** or **(530) 885-7387, ext. 201**.

Please note: Due to high demand, SNAP vouchers are currently available for cats, rabbits, and dogs that are pitbull or pitbull mix only until further notice.

Pitbull/pitbull mix: Only \$25!

Once you leave a message on the SNAP hotline, a volunteer will call you back to discuss your options. If you are eligible, you will be sent a voucher that is redeemable at a participating veterinarian's office. You can also submit an application for a voucher online at www.placerspca.org.



* Please ask about the loan of a humane trap if you plan to trap, spay/neuter, release, and care for a feral cat.
