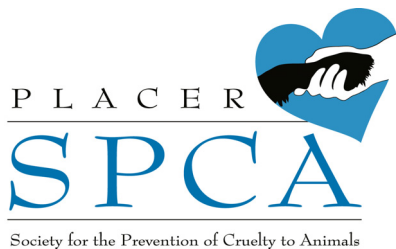

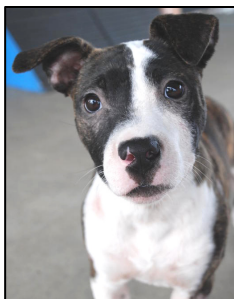
Spay Neuter Assistance Program

How it works: You must have a Placer County home address. Your voucher will be mailed with detailed instructions about how to use it at a local veterinary clinic. Spay or neuter surgery will be at no cost to you. Fees will apply for optional services, vaccinations, or other medical treatment. Rates subject to change.
