Placer County residents can now trap, spay/neuter, and release feral and free-roaming cats for a low co-pay of only **\$5.00**.



Did you know? Cats can have two to four litters per year, starting at only four months old.

If you have free-roaming cats living nearby, please take action!

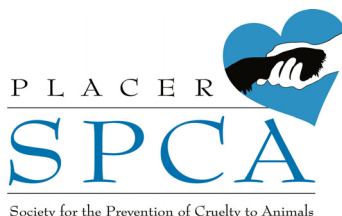

To participate:

- 1) Contact the Placer SPCA SNAP Program at the number above to request a voucher, or complete a voucher application online, found under Services at **placerspca.org**. If you plan to have multiple cats altered, request a separate voucher for each cat.
- 2) When you have received your voucher(s) in the mail, make an appointment with Animal Spay and Neuter Clinic, located in Auburn.
- 3) Trap the cat(s) in question. If necessary, you can borrow traps from the Placer SPCA for a refundable deposit, and you will be given step-by-step instructions.
- 4) After the spay or neuter surgery has been completed and the cat has fully recovered, release him or her to the original location.

Your voucher must be used at Animal Spay & Neuter Clinic in Auburn for the special pricing of \$5 to apply, and you must have received your voucher prior to making an appointment. This offer does not apply to owned pets. Additional services, such as vaccinations and other medical treatment, will be at an additional charge.
